7	The election commission shall decided the case	Wednesday 22 <sup>nd</sup> October, 2008
8	Any person aggrieved with the decision of the commission may appeal to the Director General whose decision in this regard shall be final	Friday 24 <sup>th</sup> October, 2008

10	The final list of voters shall be displayed at notice board and at website of the Chamber and also submit to DGTO	Friday 31 <sup>st</sup> October, 2008
11	Any person who is eligible to contest the Election for the vacant posts of the member executive committee shall send his nomination papers duly proposed, seconded by a duly registered voter and signed by the candidate, to the Secretary General on the prescribed form in accordance with the Articles of Association or rules of the Chamber. In the same manner women entrepreneurs desiring to contest the election for the reserved seats in the Executive Committee for women will submit nomination papers. 12	A copy of final list of voters shall be provided to each contesting candidate by the Secretary General. Except, the candidates of the women seats as their electoral college is Executive Committee not the general body.	Tuesday 4 <sup>th</sup> November, 2008
13	Scrutiny of the nomination papers and letter of authority by the commission. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats	Tuesday 4 <sup>th</sup> November, 2008
14	The list of nominees whose papers have been declared valid to be displayed on the notice board and the forms of withdrawal to the said nominees to be issued.	Tuesday 4 <sup>th</sup> November, 2008
15	The objection if any, to the nomination of candidates can be filed to the election commission. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats. Provided that the candidate for a particular seat will file objections for the candidate of the same seat and for the same class.	Wednesday 5 <sup>th</sup> November, 2008
16	The election commission will decide the objections filed under the preceding clause. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats.	Friday 7 <sup>th</sup> November, 2008
17	Any candidate aggrieved by the decision of the election commission may file an appeal to the Director General. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats	Monday 10 <sup>th</sup> November, 2008
18	The Director General Trade Organizations shall decide the appeal referred under the preceding clause. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats.	Sunday 16 <sup>th</sup> November, 2008
